



Which Teams have you played for in the 2021 season. (Tick All that Apply) 33 responses




How long have you played for the senior section of the club 33 responses






Why do you play at Poulton? (Check all that apply) 33 responses

Apart form Covid-19 related issues what have been the best/worst things about the 2021 season?

A good feeling of team spirit and the only thing I can think of that has been bad is the results sometimes

Best- great group of players, strong youth numbers, new nets

Worst-Lack of training wickets, large vary in selection and changing of teams- wrong plays coming up/ staying in second team. Lack of batting order changes when the top 5 didn't fire most of the season. The clubhouse set up not changing when Covid rules allowed for use of changing room.

Training- very little structure and no real focus to the sessions across all squads. Player attitude is nonchalant when they should turn up to improve and drive to win.

Inconsistencies in selection and performance have sadly affected league positions and have resulted in the 2s being relegated. Something the club can I'll afford. Communication and strategy on this subject have been poor and not obvious.

Really feel as though the 1st eleven is the sole focus of the club. Appreciate availability has a lot to do with it but always felt 2nd 11 had to suffer in terms of players the first eleven took. To me, it's crazy to have the 2nd team captain playing in the 1s.




On a scale of 1-10 with ten being the best, how much have you/your children enjoyed playing for the Poulton Senior Sides this season

Do you feel that the level of cricket offered by the team(s) you have played for has matched your abilities as a cricketer






Do you feel that the club membership fees of £80 for Senior Men along with match fees of £5, £50 for youth and £45 for Senior Women represent good value

Do you regularly attend the Club AGM? 33 responses






# **Poulton Senior Sides Survey 2021**

How aware are you of the club & pavilion structure/ownership






Which teams would you/your Children like to play for in the 2022 season.


