- Following Players meeting when intial proposed membership levels of 130 were discussed which would include teas for the season, I then went back to my spreadsheet and realised that i had not budgeted for the fact that we would need to pay teas out to those preparing them. As a result the proposed subs levels were tweaked as in attached agenda.

Average senior games across the club is 8 with some players player over 20. As a result
there is an upper limit of 150 proposed to cover all subs and any match fees for the season
for people that opt for it. This would be give us increased gift aid. This year Steve Willard is
processing Gift Aid and will generate a surge in income. Higher subs would then provide a
boost for next year's income. Regular 80 senior subscription level would increase to 100.
This alone would generate additional 1k for the club if enforced properly and collected while
still offering fairly priced cricket.

• Goal is to build cash reserves for capital projects given annual costs for the club of 20k. It is also likely that the cricket club would need to shoulder additional financial burden for the pavilion, meeting on this follows soon. 6.6k is all that currently comes from subs.

Other reasoning for the tweaked membership subscriptions is to charge those who only pay
more and incentivise more volunteers to get involved in the club by offering reduced
membership levels.

 Operationally we are targeting higher income as well with Liam Smith coming off the books and enough new coaches qualifying (Will Bathurst, Jody Lawrence, James Newman, Fred Bayliss along with Mark Robbins) to mean that we should be able to cover demand internally flipping this away from a cost. The increase in subs sets us on an improved financial trajectory, building reserves to then re-invest in the club as required, including for social events.

 Biggest issue is our lack of proper coaching methodologies and proper coach to child ratios. A considerable amount of admin is moving into the ECB Safe Hands Management Portal. We also have play-cricket registration issues in the youth section and this will need to be done at a pre-season meeting for the youth. This addresses a lot of the admin requirements, reducing the burden on a youth manager.
